POOL RULES

Opening Hours: 7.00AM UNTIL 9.00PM. (Please note that the Pool gates will not open outside of these hours.)

The Plantations Precinct Association requires all Owners, Occupiers and their guests comply with the following rules for the use of the Precinct Pool, in accordance with the Precinct Management Statement and other relevant health and safety laws.

- 1. Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied and directly supervised by an Adult at all times.
- 2. Guests may not use the Swimming Pool unless they are accompanied by an Authorised resident at all times.
- 3. All nappy aged children must wear recognised waterproof aqua nappies plus a tight fitting (around the legs) swimming costume. Changing nappies within the pool area is not permitted.
- 4. No smoking including e-cigarettes is permitted in the pool area.
- 5. Diving, bombing, running, ball play or hazardous activities are not permitted in or about the swimming pool.
- 6. Glass objects, drinking glasses, food and sharp objects are not permitted in the pool area.
- 7. The presence or consumption of drugs, alcohol, or substances within the pool area is strictly prohibited.
- 8. Private gatherings or groups greater than 10 persons including children is not permitted
- 9. No large inflatable toys are permitted.
- 10. Pets are not permitted within the pool area.

Failure to abide by these rules may result in pool access being restricted or refused.
